## NEW YORK STATE ASSOCIATION DEAF BOWLING TOURNAMENT / TOURNAMENT RULES AND INFORMATION

(We reserve the right to schedule each team and individual and make necessary changes and/or refuse any entries.)

### **Bowler:**

#1 - Must be deaf or hard of hearing and be member of the USBC. If not, he must pay the membership fee to the Secretary/treasurer and provide the true highest average, any certified leagues, excluding summer league. **(USBC Rule 319a) (USBC membership - \$21.00 or pay \$5.00 participation fee.)**

#2 – If the bowler having no acceptable entering average have last year (**minimum of 21 games per league**) or this year (2008-2009). (**Minimum of 21 games per league**) under the tournament rules shall bowl scratch **(USBC Rule 319b)**. **USBC Rules 319a 1-3** will be apply to the bowler who have the established average. **USBC Rule 319e** waived. Current average is as of 2007-2008.

#3 – **A bowler's NYSADBT average for the previous 3 years is 10 or higher pins than last season's average. NYSADBT average must be used.**

- **#3-1 / 9 games out of 3 years average are divide by 1/3 pin.**
- **#3-2 / 18 games out of 3 years average are divided by 2/3 pins.**

#4 – Not eligible to complete more than once in any events.

#5 – No PBA member, if he has left PBA for more than a year with the verified letter from the PBA, he must bowl scratch for 3 years before stórtng to use the handicap if needed.

#7 – No high school student can complete. The non-student individual must be at least 18 years old to be eligible to complete.

#8 – **Dress code:** Must wear proper attire during tournament events. Shirt: Neat with collar only and Pants or Slacks: Dress pant, Trouser, Slack and Jeans (any color) must be clean and no faded. If not follow, and then it's possible to be disqualified.

#9 – **Captain, please advice and see that your teammates follow the dress code.**

#10 – Be on time. All teams and individuals entered this tournament must be ready to bowl when scheduled. The tournament play will not be delayed for any reason such as non-appearance of the participants. Anyone who is late will be penalized the framed bowled to his arrival on the lanes. Catch will not be permitted. **(USBC Rule 322a)**

#11 – Bowler must provide to make the copy from USBC to verify your average and membership to the Secretary/Treasurer. You can log in on website – Bowl.com

### **Bowling Events:**

#1 – The bowler's handicap shall be based on 70% of the difference between his average and 210.

#2 – No individual handicap shall exceed 45 pins per game, 135 pins per event.

#3 – Double entrants must bowl in 4-Man team to be eligible for Double event. He must bowl in Singles and vice versa.

#4 - Senior Citizen, who is 55 years old or over, is eligibility on Optional prize for Team and Single events on both days.

#5 – League Secretary or Association Secretary living closest to must verify bowler's average as the highest where this is filled out.

#6 – Ask Secretary/Treasurer for more information.
